Who was the first person to have these thoughts?

Isaiah 14:13-14

"...I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God

Isaiah 14:13-14

"...I will sit on the mount of the congregation...I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High."

Lucifer's purpose was selfish

He wanted recognition that didn't belong to him

His motive was ulterior

Lucifer's outward appearance significantly contributed to his downfall

(Ezekiel 28:13)



What counsel do we have concerning outward appearance?

1 Peter 3:3-4 (ESV)

"Do not let your adorning be external-

1 Peter 3:3-4 (ESV)

...the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear — but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the...

1 Peter 3:3-4 (ESV)

...imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious."

How did God describe ornaments and Jewelry?

Revelation 17:4 (The False Church)

"The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls..."

Hosea 2:13 (God describes Israel's idolatry)

"I will punish her for the days of the Baals to which she burned incense. She decked her self with earrings and jewelry, and went after her lovers..."

God uses these examples to describe:

- 1. Idolatrous behavior
- 2. False Worship
- 3. His people turning away from Him
- 4. Outward sign of inward rebellion

Jesus says about our identity:

Matthew 7:17, 20

"...Every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit...Therefore by their fruits you will know them."
