Prayer Meeting will be cancelled during the weeks of Camp Pitch and Camp Meeting (June 9th & June 16th). We will resume with our normal schedule on Tuesday, June 23rd at 7pm.

Camp Meeting. The Michigan Adventist Camp Meeting will be held at Great Lakes Adventist Academy on June 12-20. All members are encouraged to attend at least the Sabbath services. Evangelist and revivalist Randy Skeete and John Bradshaw of It Is Written will speak on the first and second Sabbaths respectively. With limited attendance expected in Midland, we will have a single Sabbath School class on both Sabbaths, and show the live camp meeting services for our church services. There will be no fellowship meal on June 13.

All are invited to a potluck after the 11:00 church service on Sabbaths June 13th and 20th at Camp Meeting. On the 13th, the potluck will be held at the Khalil's campsite in the F loop. On the 20th, the potluck will be held at the Herthel's campsite. We do not know exact campsite locations yet, but will send an email. Behind the main auditorium is an information booth where you can look up campsite numbers. Trams operate after the services to transport people to different loops. There is one labeled that goes specifically through F Loop, and another specifically through E Loop, since those are the farthest locations from the main auditorium. Also, there is another parking area behind F Loop if you'd like to drive your car. Take Academy Rd. south to Deaner Rd. and turn right, go past the campground entrance and you'll see parking on the right in the grass just beyond. Tableware will be provided. Please bring lawn chairs and a dish to share.

General Conference Sabbath Services. Tens of thousands of Adventists from around the world will meet at the Alamodome in San Antonio, Texas for General Conference meetings this summer. These meetings are held every five years. Our church will show the live church service broadcasts from the Alamodome on July 4 and 11. On those dates our Sabbath School will be at the normal time. Light brunch foods will be served from 10:45 to 11:30, followed by the live church service broadcast from 11:30-1:30. - Replacing shingles on the church and activity center, replacing the flat roof on the sides of the activity center at a total cost of \$47,000 (we have nearly \$40,000 so far).
- Filling large cracks, resealing, and restriping the church parking lot for a total cost of \$2831.
- Filling large cracks, resealing, restriping, and repairing the bumper stops at the Community Services Center parking lot at a cost of \$2900.
