After Apple sent out a patch to secure a vulnerability for Mac computers, iPhones, and iPads, now Microsoft, Adobe, and Mozilla have released patches for the same problem on Windows operating systems and applications, various Adobe applications including Photoshop, and various Mozilla products including Firefox browser and Thunderbird email client. Google had also released an update earlier in February. No word about Linux, however. This means that almost everyone who uses a computer, a phone, or a tablet of any kind needs to update the operating system and applications.
