Where There Is No Vision Introduction: Please turn with me to Prov 29:18 and we will read a portion of our study passage for today.

"Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he."

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
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A. Prov. 29:18 KJV "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he."



I want you to participate in the sermon today. (M) When I say: "Where there is no vision" (M) I want you to say: "The people perish."

Lets do it twice.

How to know when I want you to say your part --

King James Bible seems to Indicate People of Vision

- 1. When people read this verse in the KJV, most often they apply it to people of "vision." I did.
- B. How often do you hear it said of a person: "This is a person of vision"? They can conceive of something, get it done, or provide for the future.



1. In a Political sense it may be said, "That person had vision for the future." The new nickle has a new view of Thomas Jefferson (3rd President) -- full face view. (M) Henrietta Fore, director of the US mint says, "The Full face is to commemorate Jefferson's vision for the Lousiana Purchase, and support of the Lewis and Clark expidition which opened the West. He was a man of vision."



2. In a Religious sense: I often heard it said that Robert Schuler was a man of vision, he built a religious empire; he built the Crystal Cathedral.

I saw his vision of baptism. A fellow pastor and I went and visted his church, before the Crystal Cathedral days, few thousand there; he was known for drive-in church.

That morning it was announced that there was going to be a bapitsm; I began to look around for the baptistry. Then it was said there would be 150 candidates; I wondered about the robes and where they were changing; who would have to care for all those robes. Then all candidates were asked to come forward, knelt, pastors got a small bowl, dipped finger in water, made sign of the cross on their forhead, said "I baptize you . . . " What a visionary! But not Biblical.

A Shared Vision

Cast Your Vision

3. I attended a NAD Leadership convention in St. Louis -- We had a very Expensive speaker there to teach us to have "A Shared Vision." (Our own visions coming together.) (A) At another NAD convention a few years later, we were challenged to "Cast Your Vision."

Have A Vision for Your Work

However --It Is Not About Us!

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5. Once upon a time, we had a church leader in a certain conference, who presented this verse at workers meeting, and he challenged us to have vision for our work; think big; think grand, plan big, execute our plan.

And we bought it, we believed this is what the verse meant. It wasn't until recent times that I had the opportunity to study this passage more carefully, and (M) I discovered that the perspective we have been following in these examples is totally erronious. It is not about us.

Yes, we may plan great things for the Lord's work. Jesus said we would do greater works than He did. But don't base it on this passage.

Lets go back to the verse:

I. "Where there is no vision . . . "

I. "Where there is no Vision"

A. Sometimes, when we want to understand a passage, it may be helpful to read it from different translations.

NASV "Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained. But happy is he who keeps the law."

NKJV "Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; but happy is he who keeps the law." NASV "Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained. But happy is he who keeps the law."

(M) NKJV "Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; But happy is he who keeps the law."

The Meaning of "Vision" and
"Revelation"

A "Prophetic Vision" Words, or
Message of the Prophet

- B. "Vision Revelation" -- "Where there is no revelation . . . "
- 1. We live in an age where people have all kinds of revelations. -- •How to get wealth. •What truth is no longer important •How the world is going to end, etc.
- 2. But look at the NKJV margin, you will see that it is not just any kind of revelation that is spoken of here. (M) The margin indicates a specific revelation, it says "prophetic vision."
- 3. The Hebrew word indicates prophecy,
- •it is a revelation from God;
- •it is God speaking through a dream, a vision,
- •It is God speaking through the Holy Spirit.

The revelation here indicates the work of a prophet, the message of the prophet as the Word of God.


What is the Vision? The words, or message of the Prophet.

II. "Where there is no vision, (no revelation from the prophet), the people perish."

Three Reasons for their being no vision.

II. "Where there is <u>no</u> vision, (no revelation from the prophet,) the people perish."

Why would there be no vision? (M) We will look at three reasons why there may be no vision, no revelation, no words of the prophet.



- A. Reason number one: Maybe it has been a long time since there was a prophet; maybe there was no living prophet. Ps 74:9; 1 Sam 3:1
- (M) Ps 74:9 "We do not see our signs; there is no longer any prophet . ."
- (M) 1 Sam 3:1 "Then the boy Samuel ministered to the Lord before Eli. And the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no widespread revelation."

There may have been hundreds of years between prophets. It may be that there was no living prophet at a given time. It did happen. The intertestamental period, for example, the time after Ezra/Nehemiah until Jesus' day there was 400 years between prophets.

With print, computer, no excuse for us today.

B. The Priests – the Clergy – took it away; disregarded it discredited it; kept it from the people.

B. Reason number two: The Priests - the Clergy - took it away by: - disregarding it; discrediting it; keeping it from the people.

From Aaron's day to this day, it happens.

This is a serious and very sad issue.


1. Geneva Bible was first published in 1557.

It was a Bible of the Reformation. It had marginal notes that came from spiritual leaders like John Knox and John Calvin. These notes spoke very plain truths - They were not concerned with being PC (Lk 11:45). The common people loved it.

|| •It is the Bible that John Bunyon, John Milton, the Pilgrims, and Wm Shakespeare used.

|| •While common people relished the notes; •King James did not. The notes reproved him. The King James version of the Bible was commissioned, in part, to produce a Bible without the Geneva Bible marginal notes (King James put that purpose in print.)

Geneva Bible on Prov 29:18:




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2. Here is what the Geneva Bible taught on Prov 29:18

a. "vision" the Notes said, meant instruction in God's truth, which was by prophets, through visions (1Sa 3:1).

- b. (M) "No vision" The notes said, meant No prophecy; no publick preaching of God's word.
- c. (M) No vision meant = "Where there are not faithful ministers of the word of God"



- 3. Lets consider the example of Pastor Aaron Ex 32:21-25 Background
- "And Moses said to Aaron, "What did this people do to you that you have brought so great a sin upon them?" 22 So Aaron said, "Do not let the anger of my lord become hot. You know the people, that they are set on evil.

18

23 "For they said to me, 'Make us gods that shall go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.'

24 "And I said to them, 'Whoever has any gold, let them break it off.' So they gave it to me, and I cast it into the fire, and this calf came out." 25 Now when Moses saw that the people were unrestrained (for Aaron had not restrained them, to their shame among their enemies),

- a. Who was the prophet of the day? Moses
- b. Who was the pastor of the day? Aaron Aaron failed to uphold the words of the prophet.
- c. You must pray for your pastor, for the pastors of this conference, for the pastors of this denomination, that they will speak publicly and live openly the vision, the revelation of the prophets. It is serious for Ja 3:1f says that teachers, (Pastors, Elders) have a stricter judgment. Recognize that you are asking to be restrained by the prophets words through your Pastor.

C. The people ignore it.

C. The third Reason there is no vision is that the people ignore it.

Amos 8:11 11 "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord God, "That I will send a famine on the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord

2. Neh 9:26 "Nevertheless they were disobedient and rebelled against You, cast Your law behind their backs and killed Your prophets, who testified against them to turn them to Yourself; and they worked great provocations.

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27 Therefore You delivered them into the hand of their enemies, who oppressed them; and in the time of their trouble, when they cried to You, You heard from heaven; and according to Your abundant mercies You gave them deliverers who saved them from the hand of their enemies.

The next word is one of the saddest words in the Bible - short word BUT

28 "But after they had rest, they again did evil before You. Therefore You left them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had dominion over them; yet when they returned and cried out to You, You heard from heaven; and many times You delivered them according to Your mercies,

29 and testified against them, that You might bring them back to Your law. Yet they acted proudly, and did not heed Your commandments, but sinned against Your judgments, 'which if a man does, he shall live by them.' and they shrugged their shoulders, stiffened their necks, and would not hear.

The people would not hear the vision. Where there is no vision, the people perish!

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
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2 Chron 36:15,16 And the Lord God of their fathers sent warnings (some don't like warnings - bridge is out) to them by His messengers, rising up early and sending them (God does not slumber or sleep), because He had compassion on His people (God wants us to be saved) and on His dwelling place. 16 But they mocked the messengers of God, despised His words, and scoffed at His prophets, until the wrath of the Lord arose against His people, till there was no remedy.

The people would not hear the vision. Where there is no vision, the people perish!



Ezk 33:30-32 "As for you, son of man, the children of your people are talking about you beside the walls and in the doors of the houses; and they speak to one another, everyone saying to his brother, 'Please come and hear what the word is that comes from the Lord.'



31 "So they come to you as people do, they sit before you as My people, and they hear your words, <u>but</u> they do not do them; for with their mouth they show much love, but their hearts pursue their own gain.




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32 "Indeed you are to them as a very lovely song of one who has a pleasant voice and can play well on an instrument; for they hear your words, but they do not do them.

What is the difference: Don't hear the words or hear the words and do not do them? The end result is the same.

Lk 11:28 Blessed are those who hear and observe.


The people would not hear the vision. Where there is no vision, the people perish!



- a. There is no vision in our life when we do not read the prophet's words. For us today, (A) this is the Bible and the Spirit of Prophecy. I am Thankful for the Spirit of Prophecy.
- b. (M) There is no vision in our life when we discount the prophets words, when we refuse or reject their authority "That was for a different day." "Things are different today." "That is not important today."

Do you hear any of that today? Outside the Church? Inside the Church?




c. The week of Dec 3, 2006 on an episode of ABC's "The Practice" the prominent theme was dealing with same sex marriage. A coach from Childress, TX wrote to ABC via their Web Site and spoke of the moral deprevation of that program, and he quoted Scripture (Romans 1 for example) and said he would boycott ABC. Read the response.

"How about getting your nose out of the Bible (which is ONLY a book of stories compiled by MANY different writers hundreds of years ago) and read the Declaration of Independence (what our nation is built on), where it says "All Men are Created equal," and try treating them that way for a change!

Or better yet, try thinking for yourself and stop using an archaic book of stories as your lame crutch for your existence. You are in the minority in this country, and your boycott will not affect us at ABC or our freedom of statement."

Again, there is no vision when we discount the prophet's words. We live in an age when people say, "We do not need the vision." "The vision is wrong." But where there is no vision, the people perish.



III. For whatever reason -- "Where there is no vision, the people perish"

A. The NKJV says "the people cast off restraint." The NASV says, "the people are unrestrained"

1. This was the circumstance among the Children of Israel.

2. When Aaron failed to uphold the words of the prophet to the people, they were unrestrained. •They turned their back on the covenant of God; •they turned their back on His promises; •they turned their back on His commands, •They fulfilled the desires of the natural heart and every man did what was right in his own eyes -- and the clergy helped them! And the same thing is happening in the religious world today.

Perish = "the people are naked"

The prophet's message to God's people of the last days is:

"... And do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked." Rev 3:17

B. For the word "perish" the Hebrew literally says, "the people are naked."

Now that gets our attention. There are few places I want to be naked.

•I appreciate being naked in the shower.

•I do not seek to be naked in public. I would not like to be naked here, before you, today. I suspect you think the same way.

(M) Yet, according to the Bible, we just might be that way. The prophet's message to God's people of the last days is: Rev 3:17 "... and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked."




Jesus talked about a form of nakedness. The parable of the wedding feast describes a wedding of the king's son, •his own subjects were invited; •but they refused to come and some of them killed the messengers; •so the king invited any and everyone; many came, -->



Mt 22:11,12 "But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment. 12 So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment? (M) And he was speechless."

The man stood naked; •he did not have the wedding garment; there was no excuse. •The consequence of being without the garment was to be bound and cast into darkness. The day is coming when those without the wedding garment will spend 1000 years in the darkness of death on this earth.

In this world today, there are many who stand publicly without the wedding garment, and their voices are raised, they have much to say. •But a day is coming when they too shall be speechless! Without the garment, they shall perish.




The only clothing for this hour of earth's history is the robe of Christ's Righteousness. To have anything else is to be naked.

C. The people perish -- Spiritual leaders of the past said:

1. "Perish" or as the Hebrew may be rendered, are made dissolute.

2. The faithful dispensation of divine truth is the only hope of a nation. Where this is wanting the people will sink into ignorance and corruption, till their destruction becomes inevitable.

3. "people perish" -- are deprived of moral restraints.



IV. "Where there is no vision, the people perish, But happy is he who keeps the law."

A. There is no happiness apart from obeying God's law from our heart. To obey His law is to obey His prophets, for the law and the prophets have always been linked.

1. 2 Kg 17:13; Mt 7:12; 11:13; Lk 24:44 The law and the Prophets are together

2. Ps. 19:7-11 The law and the testimonies - are together

3. These are Happy - blessed -- rewarded with eternal life; Of these, Jesus said, "they shall not perish."



B. What about us today? (A) Do we keep the vision? (A) Do we yield to the message of the prophets? Consider these seven messages from the prophets, most of which will revolve around Stewardship, of the Body of the Treasury: of Stewardship of time.

This was written in a day when physicians told people it was good to use tobacco; but God said, "The Bridge is Out."
